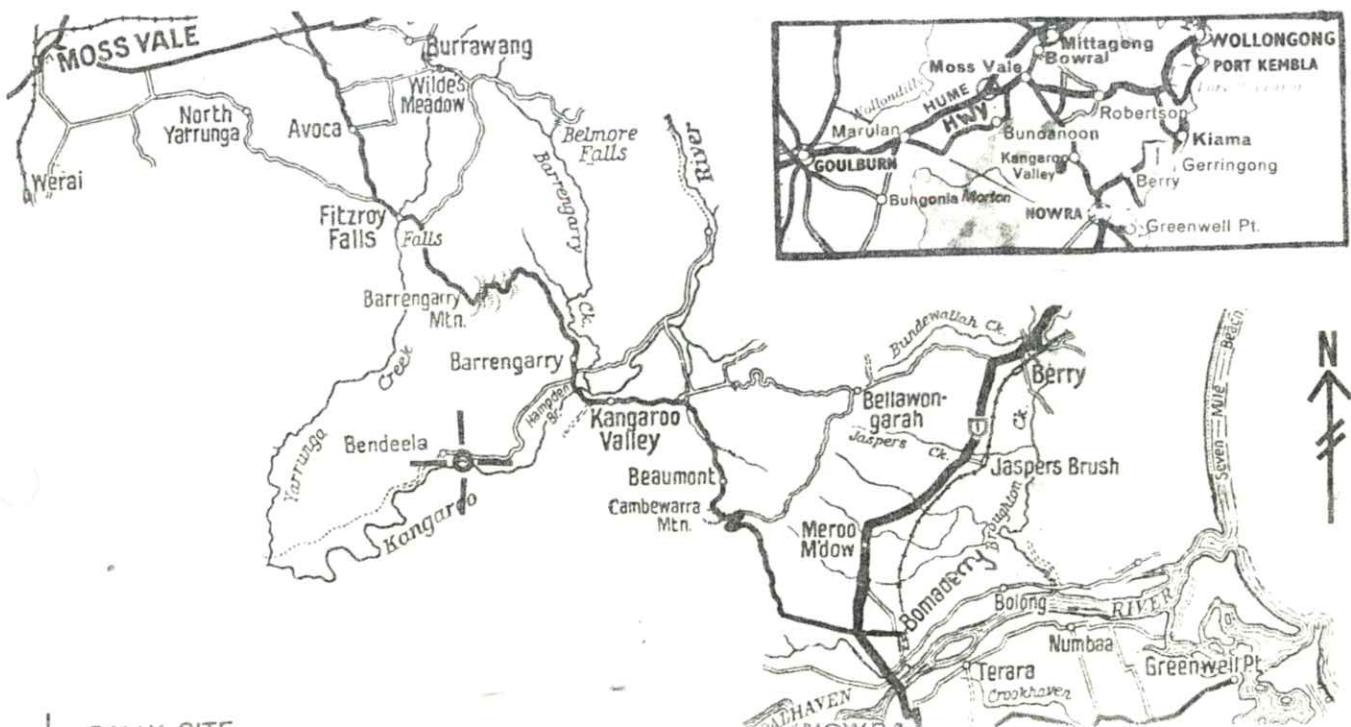

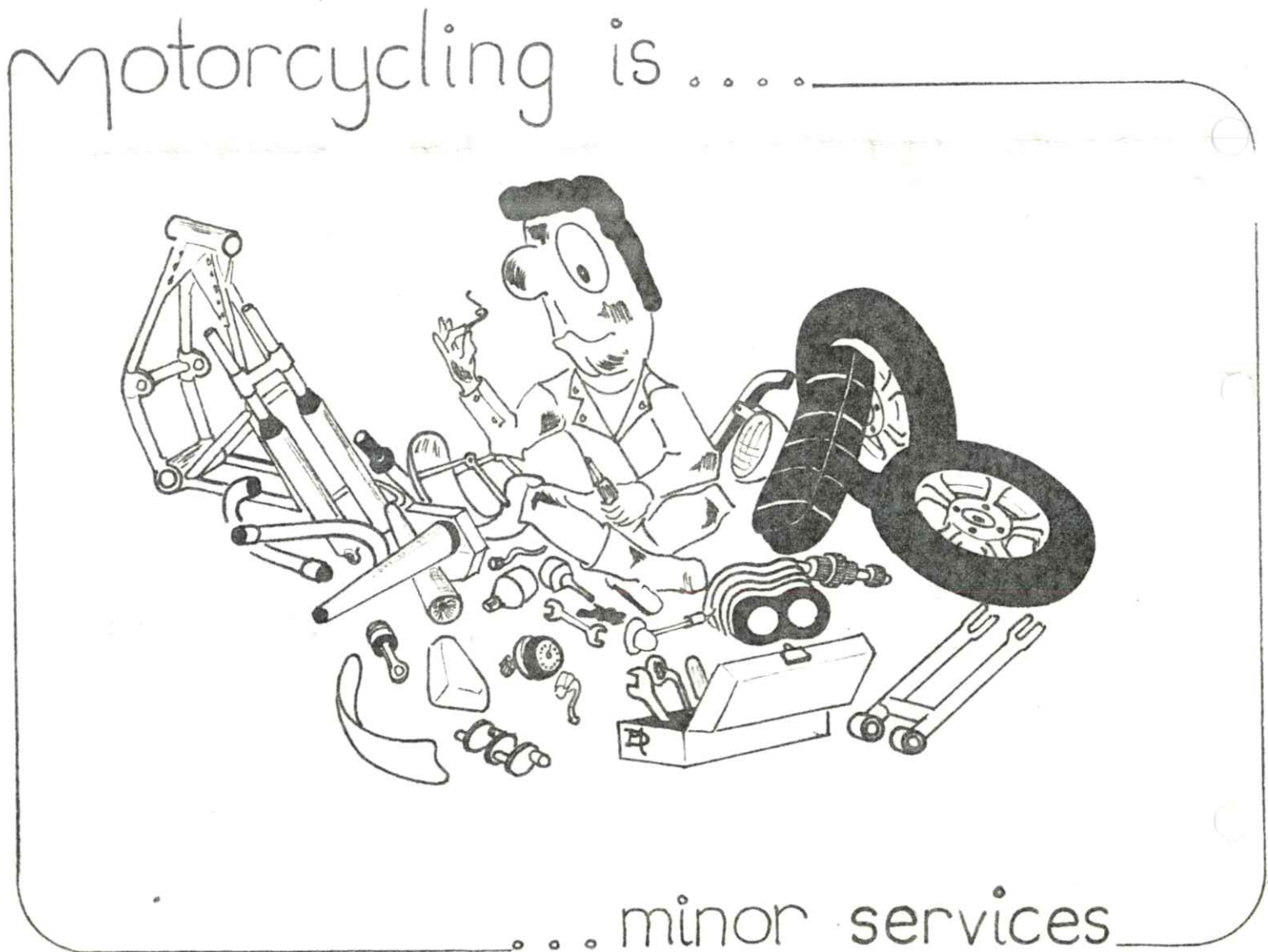


NEXT MEETING:

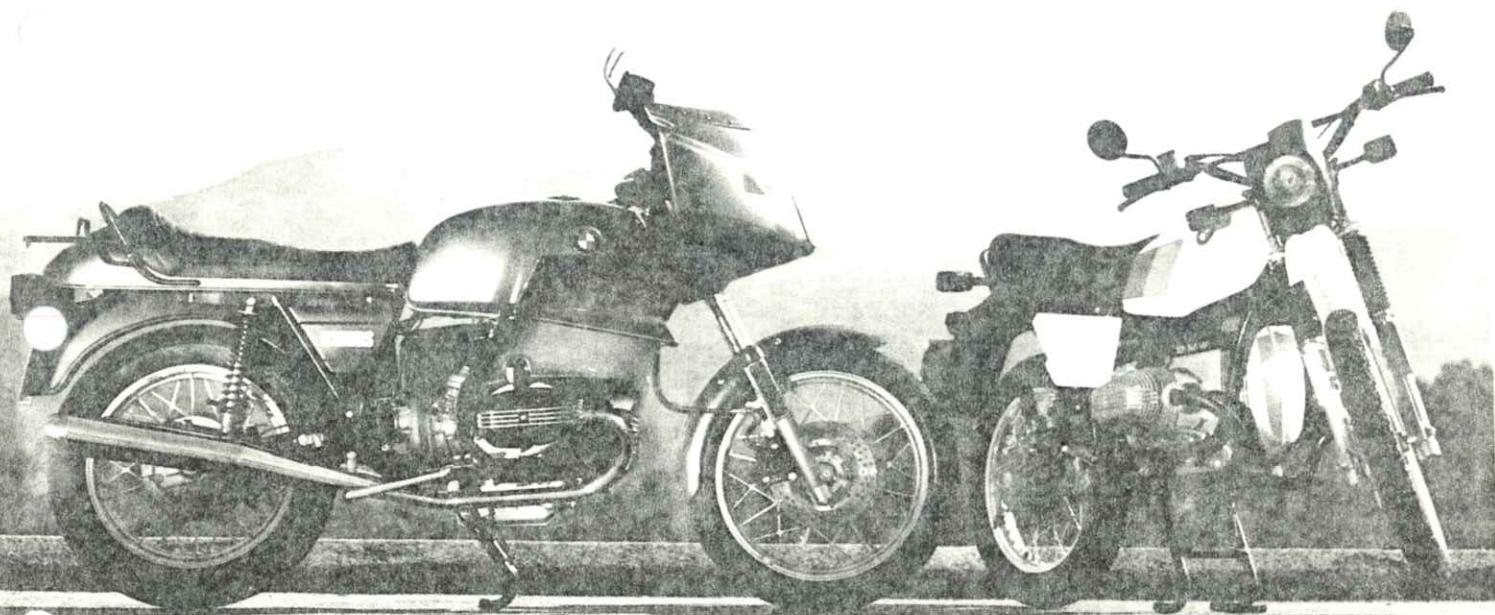
