MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER MEETING 8/9/1983.

MEETING OPENED:- 8:15 pm.

MEMBERS PRESENT:- 16, + 2 New members,- Alex Leitch and George Borren,
and a visitor, Karl Hoermann from IRV Australia P/L.

BUSINESS: Long talk by the President about the trip to BMW Australia's Head Office in Melbourne to meet with the other states respective club's Presidents, and to learn about the new K100's. as well as to discuss what BMW Australia would like to do to improve the relationship between the riders of BMWs and the dealers and the company.

Some of the main points: BMW is to continue with the Boxer twin design as well as the new water cooled 4 cylinder type, (up to 800 cc twins) and wants to assure us that parts etc. for the existing range will continue to be readily available as required. The new bikes will be sold and marketed along with the current range with the exception of the R100 series which will be dropped from the local market by about January next year. And the new bikes will be on show at the Castrol 6 Hour race in October, then one is to come to Canberra for Display in the Belconnen Mall for a week, (as mentioned last month.)

The standard K100 will be the only version available till early next year when the RS and RT type will be released. (Though they may not be called that,) Prices were not given to date, how ever the price may be one of the big surprises when they become available, as it may not be as high as some people had expected.

Mention was made of the BMW helmets being available soon (as you will read else where in this issue.) and the range of BMW accessories was on display, strong recommendation was given for the BMW wet weather suits and kidney belts by Steven Crouch and Miles Stilvano, as they recently had to ride a couple of new R100's up from Melbourne to Canberra and back, mostly in the rain..

BMW also would like more feed back from the clubs on what they should do with the bikes we ride and buy, i.e. should they put bigger fuel tanks on the R80GS and smaller handle bars on the R80ST etc. They also asked about the type of advertising that is being used at present to broaden their appeal to new motor cycle buyers, the final event of the day was to see a film of the new K100 showing some of it's finer points and how it handled etc. All in all the new bike should be well worth waiting for and is very impressive.

GUEST SPEAKER: Karl Hoermann brought along the ULTRA wild life protection device, (Brouchure included.) and explained how they work and where to fit them etc. showing some photoes of the units fitted on bikes, cars, and even aircraft. the club has purchased 10 kits (After a motion was put, seconded, and voted on.) and they are available from Ian Hahn for \$24:00 members, or \$30:00 non members.

CORRESPONDENCE: Letter from the AFP Liaison Advisory Committee asking the club to offer suggestions on motor cycle rider training and permits etc. (The President is to attend the next meeting) BMW Touring Club of NSW sent more information on the long week end at Louth.

Club journals from NSW, and VICTORIA. (Arrangements to send our journal to the club in W.A. to be made.)

MEETING CLOSED: After some discussion about supper, in future we will be providing biscuits etc. from club funds and members will be asked to donate 20¢ towards costs. (Motion put, seconded and voted on.)

BMW Australia have at last been able to get their BMW full face helmets made to meet the Australian standards requirements, this is good news to those that have waited to see how this unusual styled helmet would look 'in the flesh' so to speak, after seeing them in BMW brochures etc. As these helmets could not be legally sold in Australia 'till now. (They feature a lift up front piece, and several other special items not found on other types of full face helmets.)

WHAT, WHEN, WHERE,....

Glass fibre construction with swivel chin support, chin strap with push button lock, wind spoiler chin plate, (Removable in hot weather, if required.) Side spoiler edges (?) Anti misting visor, One hand operation visor opening to several positions, with the option of off road helmet shield/peak to wear with out visor.

COLOURS, Choice of three:-Silver metallic, White with Orange trim, White with Silver trim.

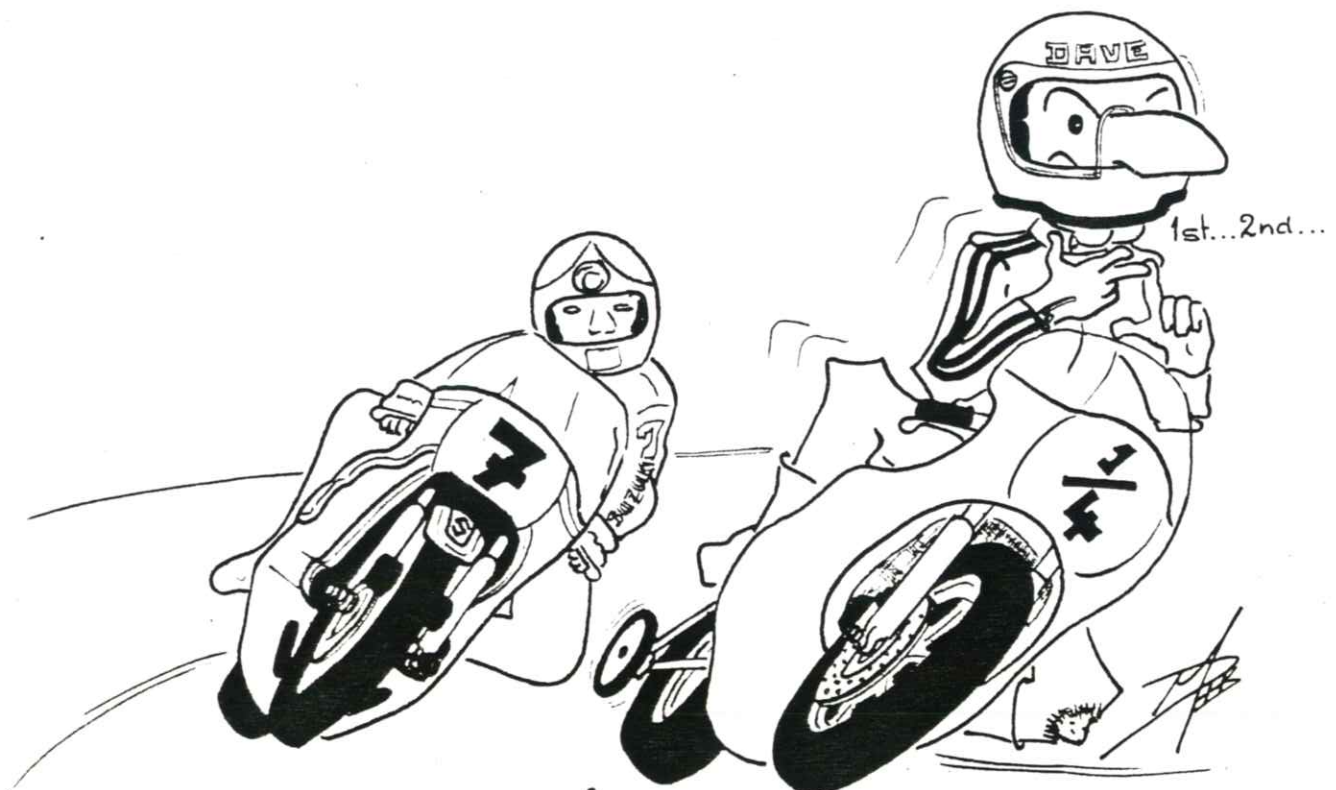
SIZES: - 7 sizes will be available in metric 2mm graduations, 50-51, 52-53, 54-55, 56-57, 58-59, 60-61, 62-63.

PRICE:- Approximately \$190:00 (Which compares well with other top of the line full face helmets of other brands now available in town.)

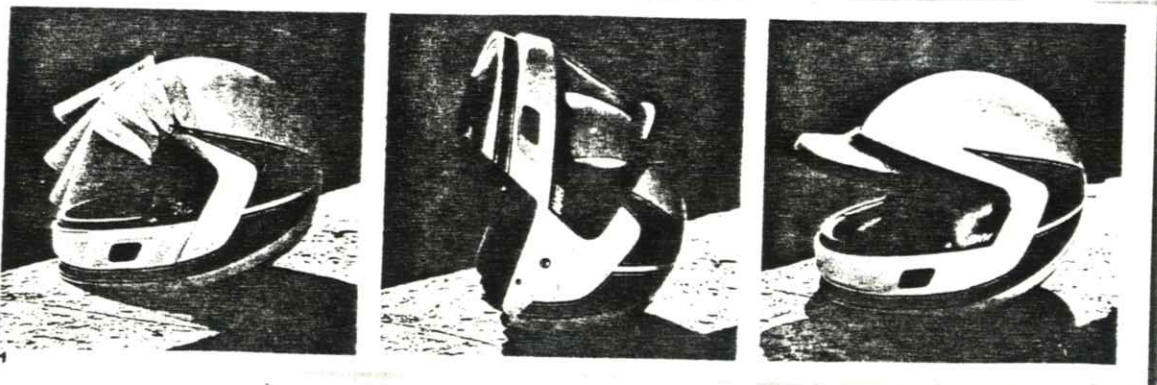

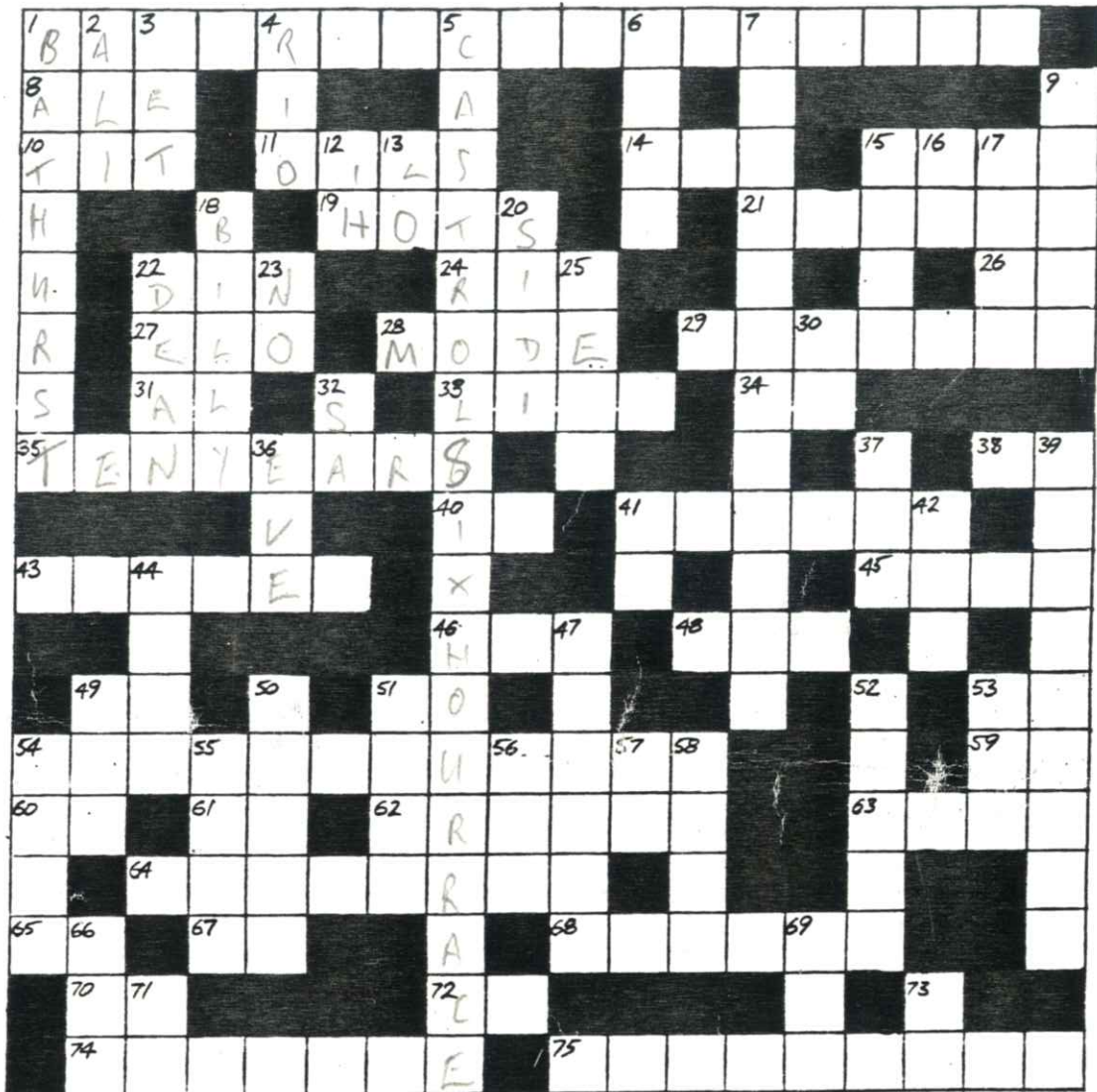
