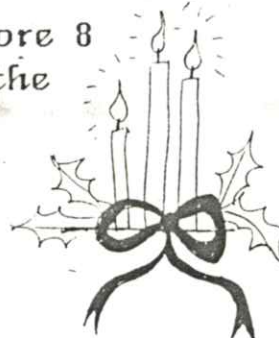


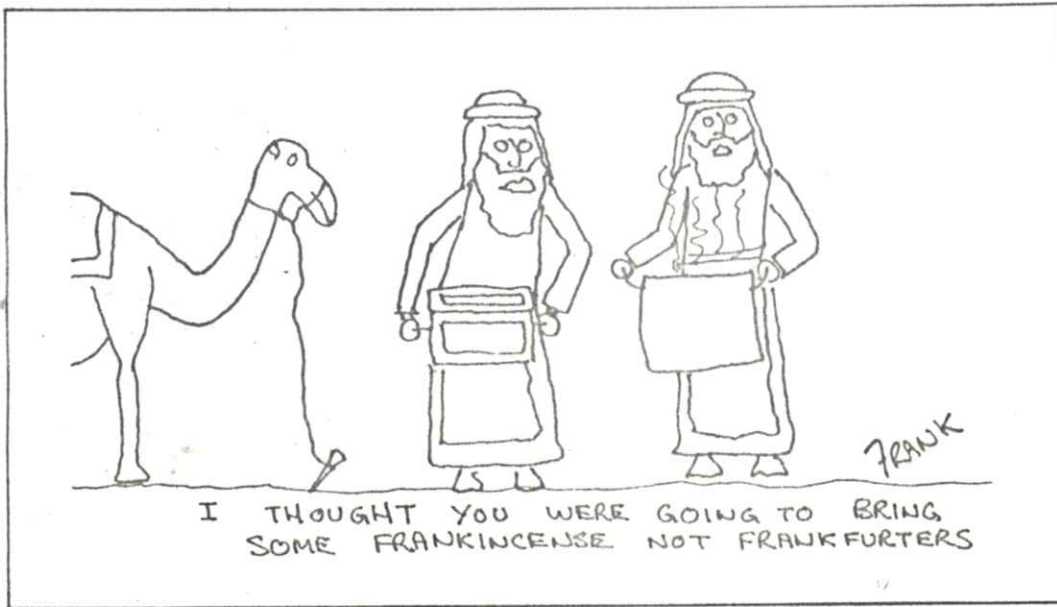

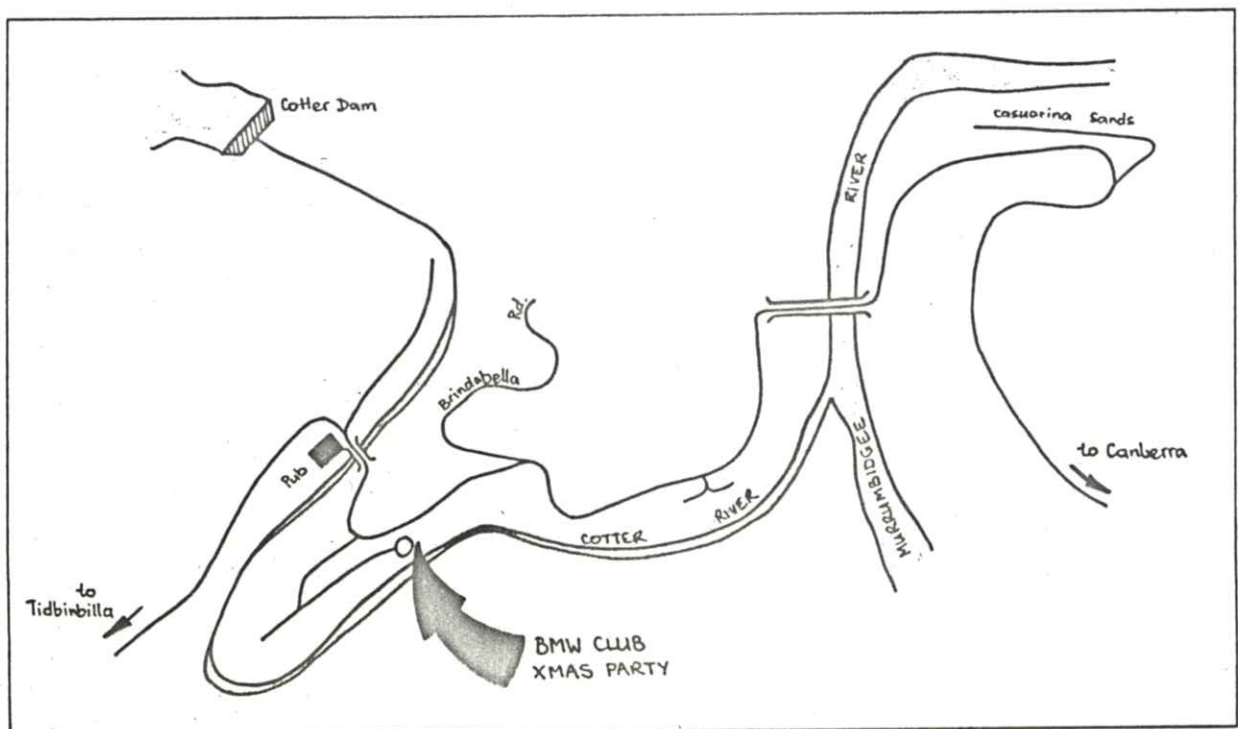
## BMW ANTILOCK BRAKING SYSTEM

The new BMW ABS braking system takes all the guesswork out of braking. It will most probably be one of the greatest safety innovations to come to the motorcycle. All thanks to BMW.

It's a tuff problem, when faced with a hazard in wet or slippery conditions none of us make full use of braking power at our fingertips. We just don't know how hard we may brake in these situations, too much brake will be ineffective in stopping us before we hit the hazard. Consider that at 100kph (only the foolish ride at these speeds in the wet), bike and rider are travelling at 28 meters every second. So as you think about stopping, time is wasted in bringing effective braking and power to bear. This hesitation only brings you closer to the object you are trying to avoid. BUT . . . if you know that your brakes aren't going to lock and lay you over with 200kg of BMW on you, THEN . . . imagine if you could squeeze a fistful of brake in the knowledge that your brakes wouldn't lock. Wouldn't that be good.

Well it's here. Thanks to BMW the ABS system doesn't necessarily mean that you will be able to brake in shorter distances. It DOES mean that you will be able to brake at a rate that was impossible before, because of the fear factor of going down.

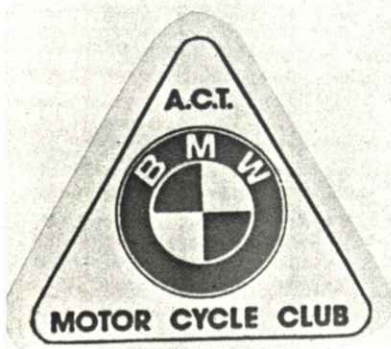
